APPLEDRAM Sussex	Medium Dry	7.5%	Cider of Festival S Downs 2006. Very clear, pale yellow. Refreshing sharp Cox taste, medium length. Vanilla finish.
BATTLE Sussex	Medium	6%	Mixed cider & other apples. Pale yellow. Slight sulphur, but very pleasant.
CHIDDINGSTONE Kent	Medium Sweet	7.5%	Wine-like in quality and finish. Fairly clear and pale. Tropical fruit taste, dry finish.
CHUCKLEHEAD Devon	Medium	7%	Hampshire cider from Devon cider apples
CROSSMAN Somerset	Sweet	6%	Unfiltered farmhouse cider. Golden yellow. Smells of straw & apples. Sweet, musty flavour, very appley.
DOUBLEVISION CIDER Kent	Medium	7.4%	Culinary/dessert blend, very quaffable.
GREEN VALLEY RUM TIDDLY TUM Devon	Medium	8.3%	Beware of rum tiddlyness....Rum cask-conditioned cider from cider apples.
GWATKINS STOKE RED Herefordshire	Medium	7.5%	Sumptuous and full-bodied. Cloudy. Sweet start on taste, diminishing to dry finish.
GWATKINS YARLINGTON MILL Herefordshire	Medium	7.5%	Exceedingly popular...Cloudy orange, with bits in. Slightly bitter flavour.
GWYNT Y DDRAIG BLACK DRAGON Glamorgan	Medium Dry	7.2%	Oak conditioned Welsh cider. Pale gold. Musty, woody smell. Medium sweet, slight rum finish. Still working.
GWYNT Y DDRAIG HAPPY DAZE Glamorgan	Medium Dry	4.5%	Easy drinking session cider.
GWYNT Y DDRAIG KINGSTON BLACK Glamorgan	Dry	7.2%	Well-balanced with gentle tannins.
GWYNT Y DDRAIG BROWN SNOOT Glamorgan	Medium Dry	6%	Clean-tasting single varietal, dry finish.
HANCOCK'S Devon	Sweet	6%	Clear, dark gold cider, fruity and

			clean-tasting.
JB'S Sussex	Dry	7.5%	South of England Regional Cider winner 2008. Local orchards, purely cider apples. Dry is VERY dry, medium is MEDIUM DRY, less Kingston Black than usual so not as tart as previous years. Clean, refreshing.

LYNE DOWN Herefordshire ROARING MEG CIDER	Dry	6%	Slightly tart, refreshing, easy-drinking, made from cider apples.
MONTGOMERY Powys OLD MONTY CIDER	Dry	4.8%	Cider apples. Full of traditional character. Very spicity on nose – possible rum cask? Tastes stronger than it says!
OAKWOOD E. Sussex	Medium (organic)	6.4%	Smell of freshly pressed apples and butterscotch. Slightly woody aftertaste.
OLIVERS Herefordshire DABINETT	Medium Dry	6%	Fruity, rounded, single-varietal cider; short finish.
ROSIE'S Clwyd TRIPLE 'D'	Dry	7.2%	CAMRA award-winning cider 2008
ROSIE'S Clwyd RAMPANT RAM	Dry	7.2%	Rum-casked cider apples; just a hint of Caribbean warmth
ROSS-ON-WYE Herefordshire	Medium	6%	Cider apples, oak-matured. Well-balanced; for those who know their cider. Spicity farmyard aroma. Slight fizz, very fruity.
SEDLSCOMBE E. Sussex	Medium	6.5%	Culinary & dessert apples, sweetened back with apple concentrate.
SHEPPYS Somerset	Sweet	6%	Good body. Fruitiness comes through the sweetness.
SPRINGFIELD Monmouthshire SLEDGEHAMMER	Medium Dry	8.2%	Very easy drinking, but beware the strength - there's a warning in the name!
WILKINS Somerset	Sweet	6%	Created by a living legend. Well-balanced fruit and sweetness.
WISCOMBE Devon SUICIDER CIDER	Dry	8%	Rum-casked cider apples. Rounded, full-bodied.

THE PERRIES

(generally not as dry as most real ciders)

BROADOAK Somerset	Sweet	7.5%	Liquid peardrops, very clear. Underlying bitterness.
DUNKERTONS Herefordshire	Medium Sweet (organic)	8%	Dry finish, with slight peardrop acidity. Cloudy. Farmyard smell, vanilla /butterscotch finish. Slight fizz.
GWATKINS Herefordshire MALVERN HILL	Sweet	7.5%	Aka Stinking Bishop. Soft delicate perry with a hint of elderflower.
GWATKINS Herefordshire OLDFIELD	Medium	7.5%	Single varietal. Cloudy. Slight sparkle, good body and full of flavour – can almost eat this.
GWYNT Y DDRAIG Glam. MALVERN HILL	Medium	5%	Clean and fruity, slightly floral, slight sparkle.
GWYNT Y DDRAIG Glam. TWO TREES PERRY	Medium Dry	5%	Oak aged Welsh perry. Quite clear. Caramel nose, dry finish. Very lively.
HECKS Somerset BLAKENEY RED	Medium Dry	6.5%	Single varietal, oak-aged. Full fruit hit. Citrus note.
LITTLE RED ROOSTER Sussex CIDER PERRY	Sweet	8%	Mix of apples with pears. Butterscotch nose. Bitter undertones on full fruit flavour, slight spirity finish.
NEWTONS Herefordshire	Medium	6%	Blend of perry pears, very rare in 2009.
NEWTONS Herefordshire KNAPP PERRY	Medium Sweet	5.5%	Still quite young – pressed Dec 09 – with slight ‘green-ness’, but very tasty.
OAKWOOD E. Sussex GREENHORSE/OLDFIELD BLEND	Medium Dry(organic)	6%	Deep gold/yellow. Taste and smell of toasty butterscotch. Green overtones.
SEVERN SIDER Gloucestershire	Sweet	6.4%	Perry pear blend, whisky-casked
